1- Ammiya Lectures for the first two weeks will take place in Amman / Shatha Al Machreq Centre/ GJU partners

2- Fusha lectures for the rest of the programme / fourteen weeks will take place in GJU main campus/ Madaba

3- Tutorials& field trips / every Thursday in Amman and other Jordanian districts

**Schedule:** Total duration: September 23<sup>rd</sup> 2018 - January 24<sup>th</sup> 2019 (16 weeks)

I Introduction to Levantine Dialect Amiya: September 23<sup>rd</sup>2018 –October 4<sup>th</sup> 2018

II Courses in Modern Standard Arabic/Fusha: October 7<sup>th</sup> 2018 –January 17<sup>th</sup> 2019

(13 weeks)

III Cultural Workshop Week & Final Exams: January 20<sup>th</sup> – January 24<sup>th</sup> 2019

**Lecturers:** All lecturers are academic staff of the German Jordanian University (School of Applied Humanities, German Language Center, Consultation and Training Center). All lecturers are native speakers of Arabic and are experienced experts in teaching Arabic to non-Arabic speakers. Where needed, they are able to give explanations and support in German or English.

**Accommodation:** The GJU will support the participants in finding suitable accommodations in Amman or in Madaba.

**Programme: Intensive Course “Arabic Language and Culture”:**

- All hours mentioned in this proposal are classroom hours of 45 minutes

**II. During the Course period:**

**- Levantine Dialect Amiya:**

- 2 weeks, 5 days/week, 4 lessons per day = 40 hours
- Amiya exam =4 hours

**- Modern Standard Arabic, Fusha:**

- Lessons: 13 weeks, 4 days/week, 6 lessons daily = 312 hours
- Tutorials: 13 weeks, 1 day/week, 4 hours each = 52 hours
- Student tutors (study buddies: 1 tutor for 2 German students)

- Four guest lecturers
- Cultural week / Final exams
- Study trip to Petra / Wadi Rum (Entrance fee in Petra not included).

**Programme Fee per Student:**

2,200 Euros

The fees will cover the following items only:

(Registration fees - Health insurance- Excursion to Petra& accommodation in Wadi Rum (Entrance is excluded) Students can buy a special pass from the following website to get reductions on all their visits to cultural &historical sites <https://www.jordanpass.jo/>
